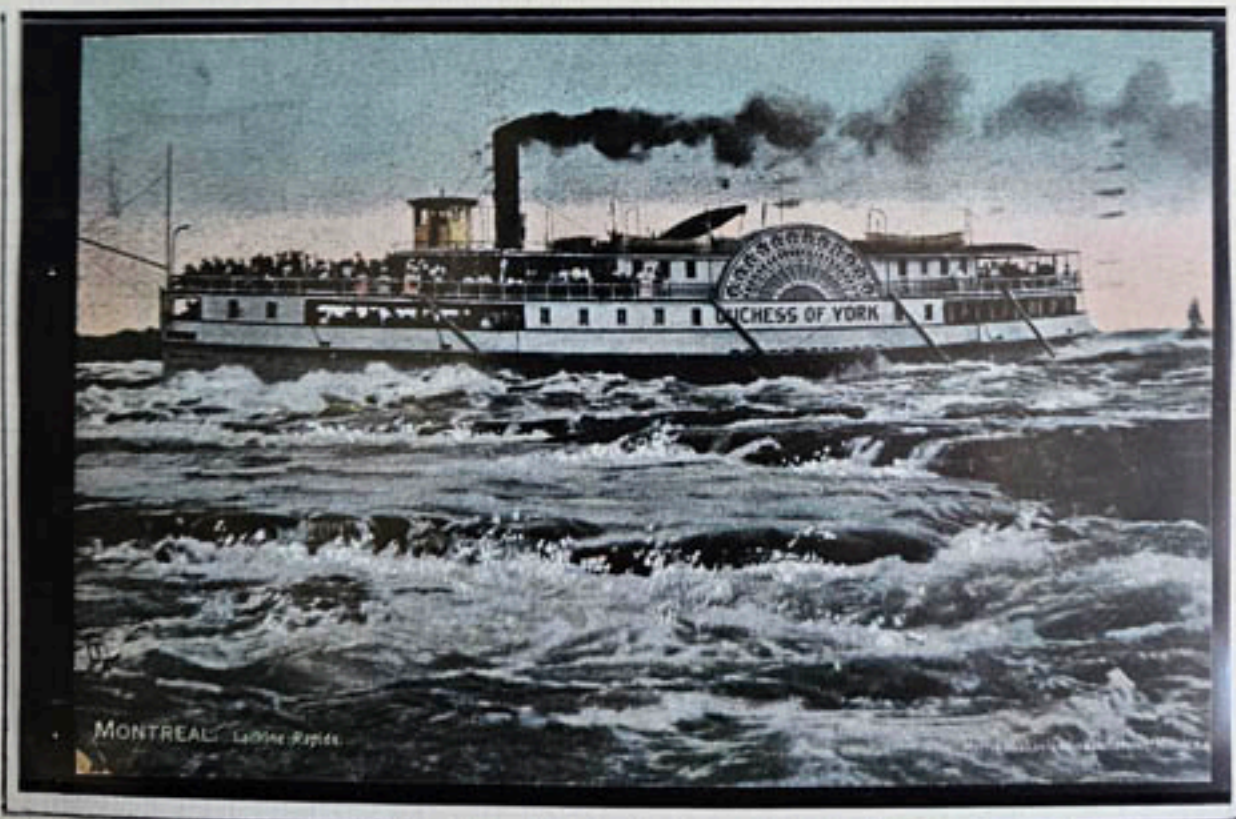

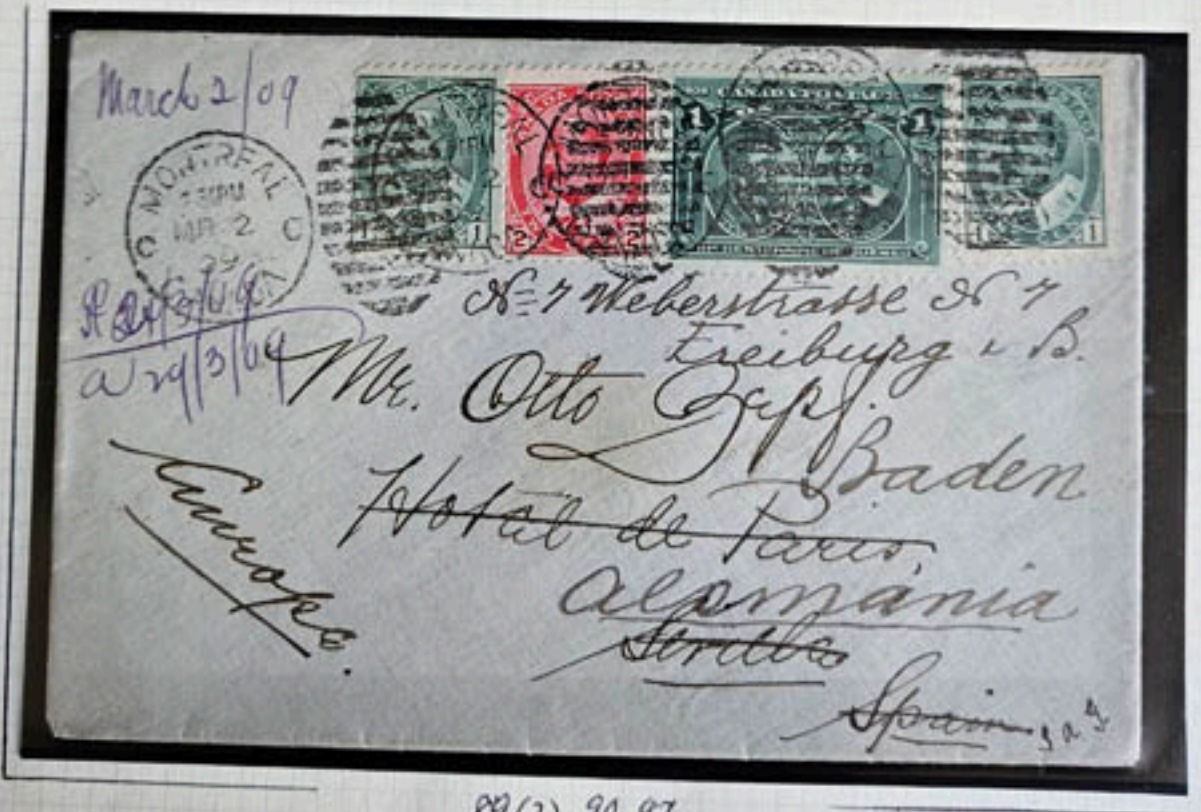
Lachine Rapids Near Montreal

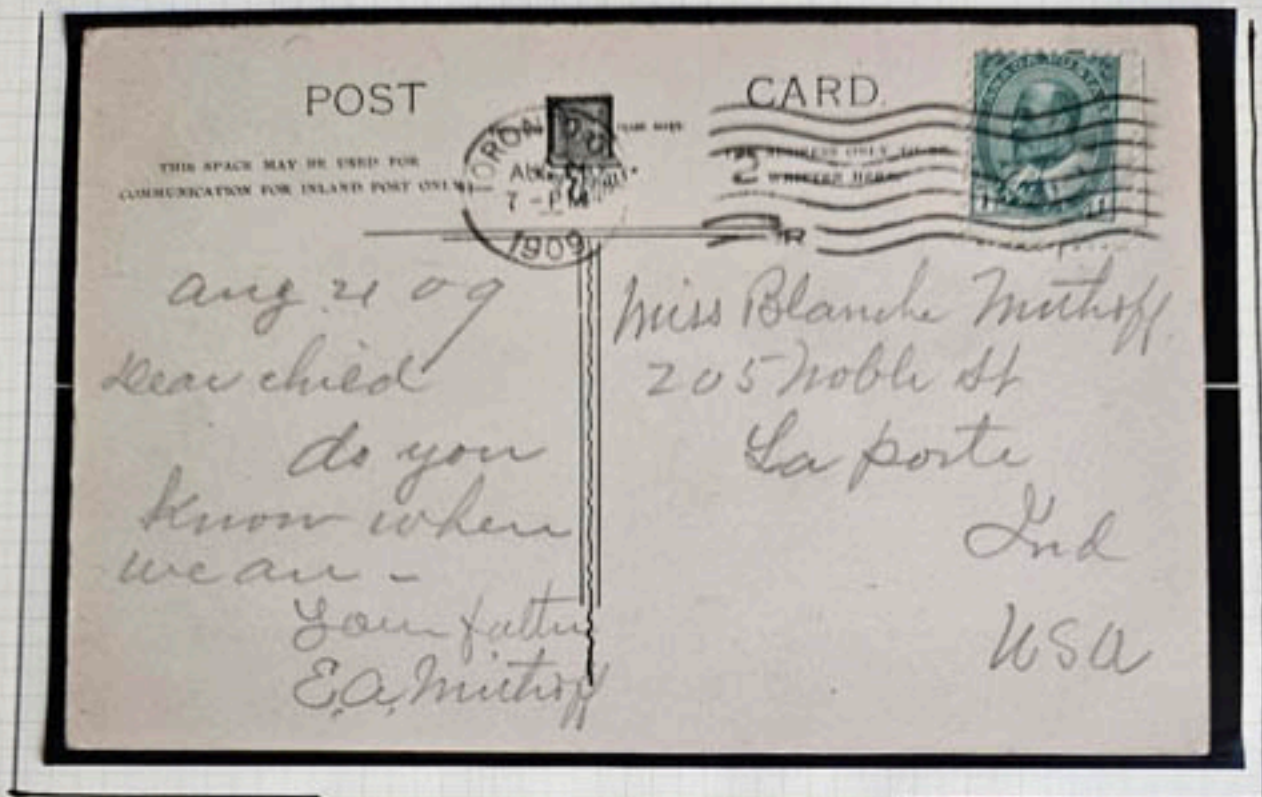
